Professional Geologist (PG), Geologist-In-Training (GIT), Certified Engineering Geologist, Certified Hydrogeologist, and Professional Geophysicist examination results will be mailed approximately December 9, 2011.

Result letters are sent by U.S. Postal Service. Please do not request a duplicate result letter unless you have not received the original result letter by December 16, 2011.

The result letters are mailed to the candidate at his or her address of record. If you have changed your address of record since the examination and you have not yet notified the Board directly, you need to complete an Address Change Request Form (available on the Board's web site) and fax it to the Board at (916) 263-2246. Submitting a change of address or forwarding request to the U.S. Postal Service is not sufficient; you must notify the Board directly.

Examination Review and Appeals

Examination review and appeals are not available for the PG & GIT examinations. ASBOG® only allows for review and re-scores when mandated by state law. California has no such law in effect for the PG or GIT examinations. For the CEG, CHG, and Geophysicist examinations, examinees that failed and are within 10% of the pass point will receive instructions on how to schedule an appeal.

Applicants Who Failed One or More Examination(s)

Applicants who took and failed one or more examinations in September/October 2011 can file a re-take application. Re-take applications for the September/October 2011 examinations must postmarked by December 23, 2011.

Applicants Who Failed to Appear for One or More Examination(s)

Applicants who did not take one or more examinations for which they were scheduled and do not have an approved "Request for Postponement" for the examination(s) in question, will be required to submit a new application for future examination(s), including all application and examination fees by the scheduled final filing date for the examination they want to take.
